

Cedars of Dexter wins 2009 Environmental Awareness award

The Cedars of Dexter was recently awarded one of two 2009 Environmental Awareness awards by the Ann Arbor Area Board of Realtors.

The independent living community, developed by United Methodist Retirement Communities, was recognized for its balance between active lifestyle options and maintenance-free living for adults age 60 and up. When completed, the facility will include 60 Craftsman-style cottages, a club house and fitness spa near historic Gordon Hall just northwest of Dexter.

The project includes landscaping and tree replacement in the grounds surrounding The Cedars of Dexter and Gordon Hall. The Environmental Awareness Award is presented by the Ann Arbor Area Board of Realtors to a Washtenaw County individual, organization, business, developer or builder, based on criteria including consideration of the environment, restoration and remodeling efforts that promote historical preservation and reuse materials.
