

Adult Learners Institute expands program to include the Cedars of Dexter

WHAT: Adult education classes ranging from general interest (movies, pop culture books) to historical to food appreciation including chocolate and wine tasting.

Classes range from one week to 10 weeks, depending on topic. The cost of each course is dependent on its length, averaging \$5 to \$10 per session. No grades, more interest-based. Courses taught by instructors from Washtenaw Community College.

Kickoff/registration event Tuesday, August 10 from 10 a.m. to Noon at Silver Maples. Instructors will be present, can learn about courses to be offered.

Cedars will start off with 1-2 classes this fall, then adjust to demand. Curriculum committee makes final decisions, but residents can take courses at any of the other campuses including the Cedars of Dexter.
