ANNUAL SHOWCASE OF HOMES TO FEATURE
THE CLUBHOUSE FOR THE CEDARS OF DEXTER

Active living community will open newly-constructed clubhouse for public display

DEXTER, Mich. – In early October, visitors to The Cedars of Dexter will get a glimpse at the clubhouse and 1,500 sq.ft. Stickley model home in the development as part of the Builders & Remodelers Association of Greater Ann Arbor's Showcase of new & remodeled homes. The showcase, which runs **Thursday, October 7 to Sunday, October 10 from 1 to 7 p.m.** each day, will tour homes in Ann Arbor, Dexter, Manchester and Gregory.

Tickets will be available in each of the homes and are good for all 4 days. \$10 each – children under 16 are free.

The Cedars of Dexter, located at 411 Cedars Lane in Dexter, adjacent to historic Gordon Hall, will feature 60 elegant cottages when completed, 38 of which have already been pre-reserved by Cedars of Dexter charter members. Amenities include modern craftsman-style architecture, spacious open floor plans with high ceilings, covered porches, patios, and four-season rooms. The Cedars of Dexter also offers maintained landscaped yards, paved walking paths. Standard upgrades include granite countertops, ceramic tile floors, Andersen windows, and barrier-free design.

The Cedars of Dexter offers a variety of amenities geared toward active seniors, and that will be showcased by our clubhouse. The over 10,000 square-foot building was designed and is being built to meet LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) certification. It will offer the residents fine and casual dining options, a fitness center with resistance machines, weights and cardio equipment, indoor salt water pool with resistant jets, hot tub and sauna. A life-learning studio for classes and special events will provide the perfect balance of active lifestyle options and maintenance-free living.
